# **Our Story:**

The African American Board Leadership Institute (AABLI) was formed in 2011 when a group of corporate, nonprofit and philanthropic leaders came together to build a pipeline of African American candidates to serve governing boards. The reason was compelling: African Americans continue to be underrepresented on a majority of boards. Many trustees across the country are engaged in important discussions about how to deliver services to communities of color. The absence of African Americans on these boards affect the quality and efficacy of policy decisions, program design and implementations.

AABLI is the only organization in the country that exclusively trains and assists with the placement of African American professionals to serve on these boards and commissions.
